Primary Purpose of Position

Reporting to the Foreman PRA, the Lead Operator will be responsible for day to day area operations and maintenance activities.

Responsibilities

- Mentor and train operators on all operational matters
- Provide input and guidance to maintenance crews and contractors working on well leases and facilities
- Provide holiday relief for Operators and Production Foreman
- Lead all BCI Reporting
- Troubleshoot and provide accurate diagnosis of well and equipment problems
- Participate and provide input into Sinopec Canada's corporate and site specific Emergency Response Plans (ERP)
- Ensure MOC process is followed
- Develop start up procedures and train junior operators on following procedures:
- Commission new well and equipment start ups
- Assist Foreman in administrative duties such as invoice coding, approval, and PVR data integrity
- Lead for the chemical management team
- Assist with other projects as directed from the Foreman and Operations Manager

- Ensure compliance with all Regulatory and Sinopec policies (i.e.: ABSA, AER, AENV, OH&S, Pipeline Integrity, BCI)
- Take a lead role in promoting safe work practices and ensures that all operators are following Health, Safety & Environment policies and procedures

- Keen attention to detail and strong organizational skills
